Your Church Can Get Involved and Partner with the Village of Don Bosco, Dominican Republic



Don Bosco is a hilltop community situated above the city of Barahona, where Children of the Nations' Dominican Republic headquarters is located. This impoverished Dominican community is home to more than 3,000 children. When Children of the Nations began its partnership with the people of Don Bosco in 2002, most of the children did not have access to basic resources like medical care, education, and sufficient nutrition.

Currently, we have around 250 children enrolled in our Village Partnership Program in Don Bosco. Alongside caring partners like you, COTN has helped build a school facility, a medical clinic, and clean water systems, as well as helping to implement daily nutrition at school, skills training, Bible studies, and summer camps.
