



Your Church Can Get Involved and Partner with the Village of Mgwayi, Malawi



The village of Mgwayi is located to the west of Malawi's capital, Lilongwe, within walking distance of the Children of the Nations Njewa Ministry Center. This community consists of about 3,000 people, most of whom do not have access to proper education, food, or health care. Due to the high prevalence of HIV/AIDS in Malawi, 53 percent of the country's population is under age 18. Most women are widowed or divorced and leading single-parent households. Residents of Mgwayi are members of the Chewa tribe, which is heavily involved in secret societies and voodoo.

COTN has around 250 children enrolled in our Mgwayi Village Partnership Program. Along with caring partners like you, COTN helps provide evangelism and discipleship for the growing Christian community in Mgwayi and HIV/AIDS testing and awareness training for those who need it. COTN is also building a secondary school at our ministry center and has constructed a community center and helped local widows start small businesses.
